

Fall foliage Road Trip

What?

We planned an easy road trip through crisp autumn air and fall foliage on two lane country roads through Loudoun County, VA.

Give your favorite ride (classic or modern) a stress-free drive before our car season comes to a close, and before the snow flies.

This is a socially distant and very safe event. And if you choose, you don't even have to leave your car!

- **10:00 AM:** We meet in the parking lot of Dunkin Donuts in a Chantilly, VA shopping center (address below).
- **10:45 AM:** We depart Dunkin Donuts and caravan out to beautiful old Rt.15N for a 30 min leisurely drive through the Loudoun County, Virginia countryside.
- **11:30 AM:** Stopping along our Route for a casual seated (outdoor) lunch in charming, historic Oldtown Leesburg, VA at [South Street Under Deli](#).

Lunch is pay-on-own with outdoor seating. Dress appropriately for the weather of the day. [click for menu](#).

Optional lunch: If you do not feel comfortable or safe eating (outdoors) at a restaurant with others, pack your lunch and dine inside the comfort of your own car or a nearby park bench.

- **After lunch:** The caravan continues on Rt.15N for an easy 30-minute drive of more stunning fall foliage as seen on the horizon along the foothills of the Blue Ridge mountains. We may do a quick stop at a roadside farmers market. Continue motoring onto the lil town of Point of Rocks, MD. ending our sojourn with dessert at the Rocky Point Creamery for a taste of farm-made ice cream (they have a drive-thru order window).
- **White's Ferry crossing**-optional: As we end our Road Trip, Marylanders may leave straight from the creamery via Rt.15S to Poolesville, MD and take the historic White's Ferry back into MD. by crossing the Potomac River into Montgomery County. The ferry can handle about 24 cars, the cost one-way is \$5.00, and the ride across the river is only about 6 minutes long to the other side. [Whites Ferry website.](#)
